I will deliver him and honor him.**

## **Psalm 139:1-4**

**1 O LORD, You have searched me and known me.**

**2 You know my sitting down and my rising up;  
You understand my thought afar off.**

**3 You comprehend my path and my lying down,  
And are acquainted with all my ways.**

**4 For there is not a word on my tongue,  
But behold, O LORD, You know it altogether.**

## **Psalm 139:5-7**

**5 You have hedged me behind and before,  
And laid Your hand upon me.**

**6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me;  
It is high, I cannot attain it.**

**7 Where can I go from Your Spirit?  
Or where can I flee from Your presence?**

## Hebrews 4:12-13

**12 For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.**

**13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.**

**13 And not a creature exists that is concealed from His sight, but all things are open and exposed, naked and defenseless to the eyes of Him with Whom we have to do.**

## **Matthew 6:26-29**

**26 Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they?**

**27 Which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature?**

**28 "So why do you worry about clothing? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin;**

**29 and yet I say to you that even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.**

## **Matthew 10:29-31**

**29 Are not two sparrows sold for a copper coin? And not one of them falls to the ground apart from your Father's will.**

**30 But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.**

**31 Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows.**

## **1 Peter 5:6-7**

**6 Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time,**

**7 casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.**

**7 Casting the whole of your care [all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares for you affectionately and cares about you watchfully.**

## **Matthew 11:28-30**

**28 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden,  
and I will give you rest.**

**29 Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am  
gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your  
souls.**

**30 For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."**

## **Romans 8:31-34**

**What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?**

**32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?**

**33 Who shall bring a charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies.**

**34 Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.**

## **Ephesians 2:10**

**10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.**

**10 For we are God's [own] handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us [taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live].**



## Psalm 23:4-6

**4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil;**

**For You are with me;**

**Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.**

**5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil;**

**My cup runs over.**

**6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me**

**All the days of my life;**

**And I will dwell in the house of the Lord Forever.**
